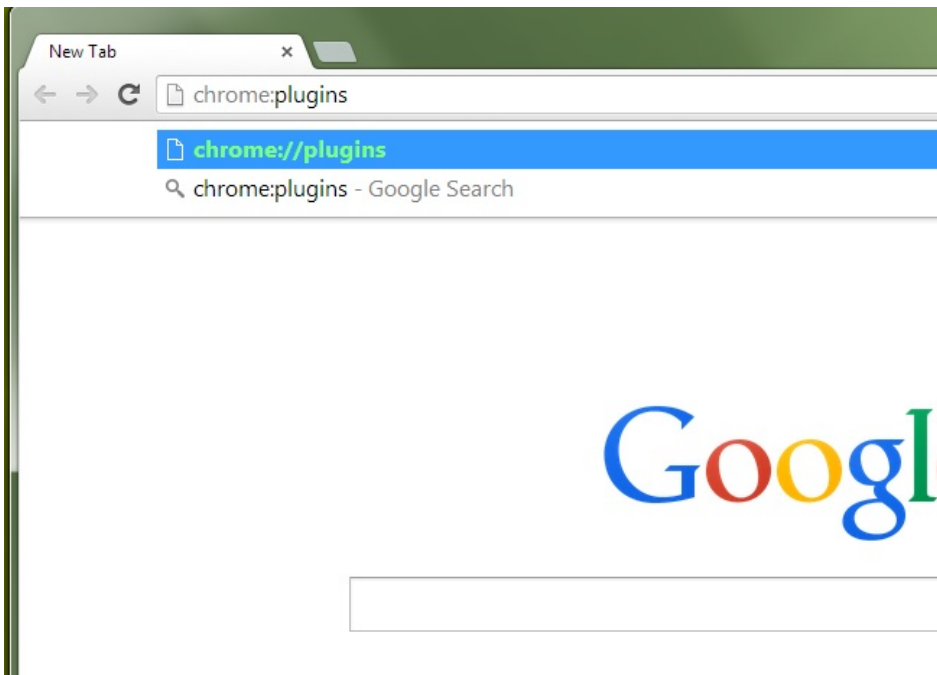


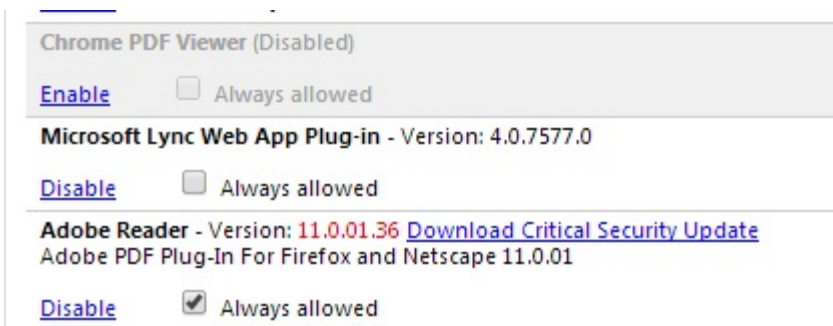
Google Chrome 33 Update

April 10th, 2014 – Google has recently released an update which disables the Adobe Reader plugin in favor of their new PDF reader. Unfortunately, like Mozilla Firefox, Google failed to consider that people may actually want to print documents in legal size format. What this means is that if you are trying to print a HUD or other document to legal size paper the document will print to letter and “chop off” a portion of the document. Fortunately your Support Staff at E-Closing has figured out how to disable the Google PDF Reader plugin and re-enable the much more user friendly Adobe Reader plugin.

Step 1: In the URL bar type CHROME:PLUGINS



Step 2: Scroll down to the Chrome PDF Viewer plugin and click the blue “Disable” link. Then find the Adobe Reader plugin and click the blue “Enable” link, as well as the “Always Allowed” check box. Your settings should look like the image below.



Step 3: Go ahead and try to reprint your documents and you should be all set!
